## Vaccination news

The district council Hub is starting to receive enquiries about transport to have the COVID-19 vaccination. CRUs may receive enquiries too, if you haven't already? Are any groups able to support residents with this?

The priority list from the [Government Priority Groups for Coronavirus Vaccination](#) (as at 2 December 2020) is:

1. residents in a care home for older adults and their carers
2. all those 80 years of age and over and frontline health and social care workers
3. all those 75 years of age and over
4. all those 70 years of age and over and clinically extremely vulnerable individuals
5. all those 65 years of age and over
6. all individuals aged 16 years to 64 years with underlying health conditions which put them at higher risk of serious disease and mortality
7. all those 60 years of age and over
8. all those 55 years of age and over
9. all those 50 years of age and over

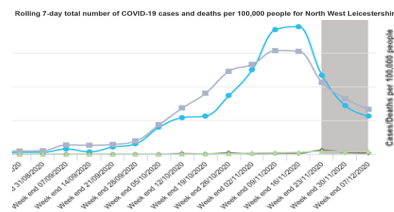
It is estimated that taken together, these groups represent around 99% of preventable mortality from COVID-19.

## Latest COVID-19 Stats

Here is some great news as we edge closer to Christmas. At the time of writing there are zero COVID-19 cases in any North West Leicestershire (NWL) care homes. That's got to be worth celebrating!

Across NWL we have seen a 39% reduction in cases across the board and only 6.9% of all tests carried out have come back positive. As a district we're continuing to head in the right direction.

However, we still need to take care. At the moment the highest number of cases lie in Coalville West ward, followed by Measham and Donisthorpe.
