1978 Planning Consultations

a. 19/00269/FUL, 97 Top Street (Redhill Farm), change of use of parts of existing buildings to B1 (R&D light industry), B8 and agriculture – no comment.

1979 Planning Decision Notices

a. 14-16 Top Street, removal of cement based render & reinstatement with lime based render – granted (listed building consent).

1980 HS2 (High Speed Train)

Various recent communication passed to members, including public consultation venues and dates – local being Ivanhoe College, 29/06/19 12-5. Details to be added to the PC web site. HS2 representatives to attend a future PC meeting, date not yet confirmed.

1981 Footpaths, Hedgerows, Street and Allotment Matters

- a. Residential encroachment onto Parish Council land – in the hands of a solicitor.
- b. Section 106 gardening equipment – Clerk has sent S106 forms to NWLDC re ride on mower for the allotment site – further information is required, as well as details re S106 request for football equipment storage next to the sports pavilion.

1982 Appleby Recreation Ground

- a. Members **RESOLVED** unanimous to purchase and install a new metal 15' gate and post for the recreation ground. Clerk to ask Mr Richard Denson to purchase and install.
- b. Clerk to ask if future Parish Council meetings could be held in the sports pavilion.

1983 General Items for Discussion

- a. New village 3D signs – Cllr Whitehurst is investigating this matter further.
- b. S106 funding – benches etc. The Clerk obtained quotes for new benches, but it appears that S106 funding does not cover these items, a query was also made re re-surfacing the area into the recreation ground, again this is not covered by S106.
- c. Co-option update – no more applications received, continue to advertise.
- d. VE Day – the 75th anniversary of VE Day from 8th – 10 May 2020 – members to talk to local residents and clubs re this matter and offer assistance from the Parish Council.
- e. NWLDC offer of community cleansing services – Clerk to request further information – is this to replace existing services, or in addition?
- f. Street lighting concerns – Clerk waiting for further information re actual areas of the Parish.
- g. Clerk to request an update re the caravan site.
- h. Clerk to obtain information re lamp post poppies – cost etc.
